

Prices for external inconsistency

(in application from 1st January 2016)

Nominations introduced by two Access Responsible Parties are externally inconsistent when the nomination introduced by the buyer is different from the nomination introduced by the seller.

Prices below are applied to the differences, in absolute value, between quarter-hourly values communicated by these two parties:

- when the power nominated by the buyer is less than the power nominated by the seller: the price (in absolute value) for a positive imbalance of an Access Responsible Party;
- when the power nominated by the buyer is greater than the power nominated by the seller: the price for a negative imbalance of an Access Responsible Party.

The amounts are charged according to the conditions as written in the contract of the Access Responsible Party (« ARP contract ») in force.
